FREE Holiday Budget Planner Tips

Make the holidays joyful—not stressful—for your wallet!

- Set Your Total Holiday Budget
 - Decide on an overall spending limit.
 - Write it down and stick to it.
- List Your Holiday Expenses
 - Think beyond just gifts—include:
 - 🎁 Gifts (family, friends, co-workers, etc.)
 - 🎄 Decorations (tree, ornaments, lights)
 - 🍽️ Food & Entertaining (holiday dinners, parties, treats)
 - ✈️ Travel (flights, gas, lodging)
 - 🎭 Events & Experiences (shows, festivals, activities)
 - 📦 Postage & Shipping (cards, gift mailing)
 - 🐾 Pet Care (if traveling)
- Allocate Amounts by Category
 - Break your total budget into spending categories.
 - Write the limit next to each one.
- Create Your Gift List
 - Write down every person you plan to buy for.
 - Assign a budget amount for each.
 - Keep a running total so you don't overspend.
- Track Purchases
 - Record what you bought, how much you spent, and what's left in each category.
 - Mark gifts as wrapped and delivered.
- Plan for Next Year
 - After the holidays, review what you spent.
 - Start a holiday sinking fund in January to save a little each month for next year.

💡 Pro Tip: The earlier you plan, the less stress—and the more cash—you'll have left in January!
